The contestants will be judged on the following criteria

- **INTRODUCTION**
- **PHYSICAL PRESENCE.** ( eye contact, body language and poise)
- **VOICE AND ARTICULATION.**(volume , pace, rhythm, intonation and clear pronunciation)
- **MEMORIZATION**

(The jury will select the winners from each class for **The Final Round**)

**Students selected for the Final Round should memorize a new poem from the given list.**

**2. Final Round-Poetry Competition** will be held on **Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2018.**

Top 3 winners will be announced.

Winners will honored in the morning assembly which will be held on **Sunday, 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2018.**
