The hanging gardens of Babylon

The Hanging Gardens of Babylon had plants cultivated above ground level. The roots of the trees are embedded in an upper terrace rather than the earth. The Hanging Gardens were a total of 56 miles long. King Nebuchadnezzar built the Hanging Garden in Babylon. (present day Iraq) The pillars, vaults and terraces were built with baked brick and asphalt.



Taj Mahal in Agra

The **Taj Mahal** is a white tomb built in the 17th century by the Mughal emperor, Shah Jahan. He built it in memory of his wife, Mumtaz Mahal. The building is in the city of Agra in India. Widely thought as one of the most beautiful buildings in the world, it is one of India's biggest tourist attractions.
